

The pilot testing of the guidEU project main outputs (ON-LINE CAREER APTITUDE TOOL FOR STUDENTS; GET TO KNOW LABOUR MARKET – GAME and TRAINING TOOLKIT) has been officially launched. Pilot testing takes place from September 2018 till February 2019 in all project partner countries (Poland, Cyprus, Spain, Turkey).

The first part of the pilot testing took place during the **Short-term exchange of groups of pupils** of the project in C.P.R. Plurilingüe Nuestra Sra del Carmen (Betanzos, Spain) between 24 – 28 September 2018, where 20 students tested the "On-line career aptitude tool for students" and the "Training Toolkit". From mid-November "Get to know the Labour Market - Game" will also be ready for testing.

We invite lower and upper-secondary schools to take part in the pilot testing of the preliminary versions of the career aptitude tool which offers unique insight into students skillset and vocational predispositions, electronic board game to prepare students for entering the world of work and career guidance lesson scenarios adapted for different age groups to contact a national partner. Pilot testing is the opportunity to get to know the tools and give us feedback on their further fine-tuning. Please bear in mind that both the tool and the game are in the development phase which means that at this stage there is no feedback for the users.

The only condition of taking part in the pilot testing is to provide us with your evaluation. After testing, project partners will prepare national report to sum up the activities and fine-tune the results accordingly.

First short-term exchange of groups of pupils

The first **short-term exchange of group of pupils** took place from 24th to 28th of September in Betanzos (Spain) and was hosted by a project partner C.P.R. Plurilingüe Nuestra Sra del Carmen.

In the exchange took part **5 students** (aged 16-18) **from each partner country** and accompanying teachers. The exchange formed part of the pilot testing of the main project outputs i.e. "Online career aptitude tool for students" and selected lesson scenarios of the "Training toolkit". During 5-days all students gathered to participate in career guidance classes and test project outputs in multicultural environment. In addition, organized visits to Betanzos, the university of Santiago de Compostela, Inditex and La Coruña were arranged to focus on increasing awareness of what higher education has to offer and explore and gain a cultural experience.

All the students stayed with host Spanish families to immerse in the country culture and language and took an active part in the family's everyday life.


At the end of the exchange the evaluation questionnaires were gathered for further outputs improvement and Europass Mobility certificates will be issued for participants.
