

The pilot testing of the guidEU project main outputs (ON-LINE CAREER APTITUDE TOOL FOR STUDENTS; GET TO KNOW LABOUR MARKET – GAME and TRAINING TOOLKIT) has been extended. Pilot testing will take place until mid-March 2019 in all project partner countries (Poland, Cyprus, Spain, Turkey).

During pilot testing, the Short-term exchanges of groups of pupils were held in C.P.R Plurilingüe Nuestra Sra del Carmen (Betanzos, Spain) from 24 to 28 September 2018 and in Zespół Szkół Ogólnokształcących w Dęblinie (Dęblin, Poland) from 21 to 25 January 2019, to test the main project outcomes and to embark on this international adventure. Both exchanges were attended by students coming from project countries.

After testing, project partners will prepare national report to sum up the activities and fine-tune the results accordingly. Schools which will participate in the pilot testing will receive fine-tuned versions of the tools and materials by the end of the project implementation.

Second short-term exchange of groups of pupils

The second **short-term exchange of group of pupils** took place from 21th to 25th of January in **Dęblin** (Poland) and was hosted by the project partner **Zespół Szkół Ogólnokształcących w Dęblinie**.

The mobility was attended by **5** students (aged 13-14) from Cyprus, Spain and Poland and accompanying teachers. The exchange formed part of the pilot testing of the main project outputs i.e. "Get to know the Labour Market - Game" and selected lesson scenarios of the "Training toolkit". During 5-days all students gathered to participate in career guidance classes and test project outputs in multicultural environment. In addition, organized visits to Lublin, JMP Flowers, "Polish Airforce Museum" and AGBO enterprise were arranged to enhance and complement careers support. The mobility allowed to release impulses for personal growth and enhance cross cultural experience.


At the end of the exchange the evaluation questionnaires were gathered for further outputs improvement and Europass Mobility certificates will be issued for participants.
